1 ISSUE

- 1.1 This report provides a breakdown of the Freedom of Information (FOI) requests received and dealt with by NHS Cambridgeshire and Peterborough during 2014/15 (1 April 2014 to 31 March 2015).

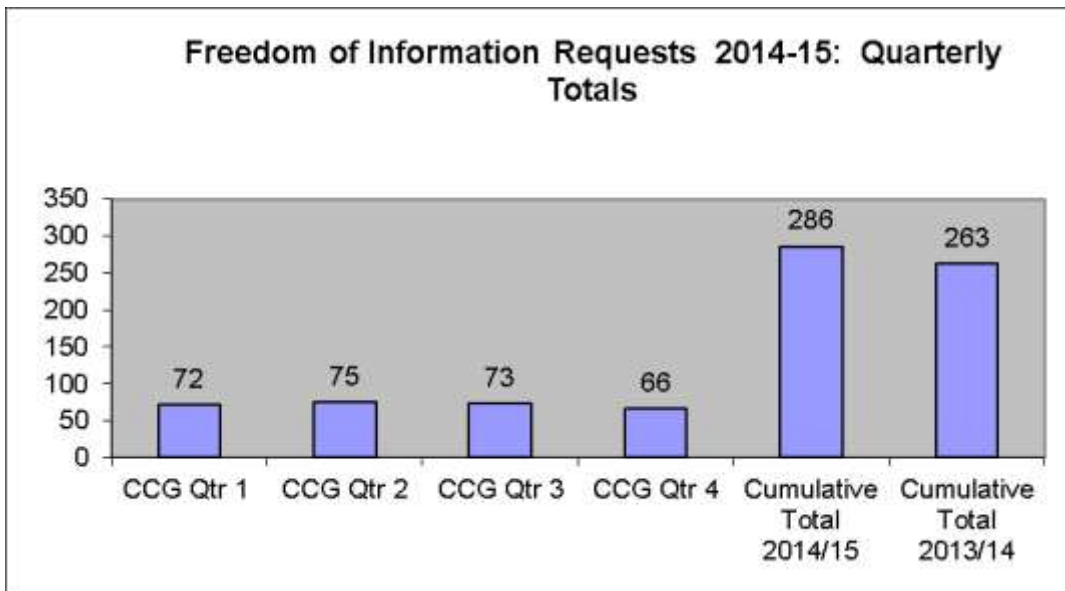

3. FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 - QUARTER 1 SUMMARY

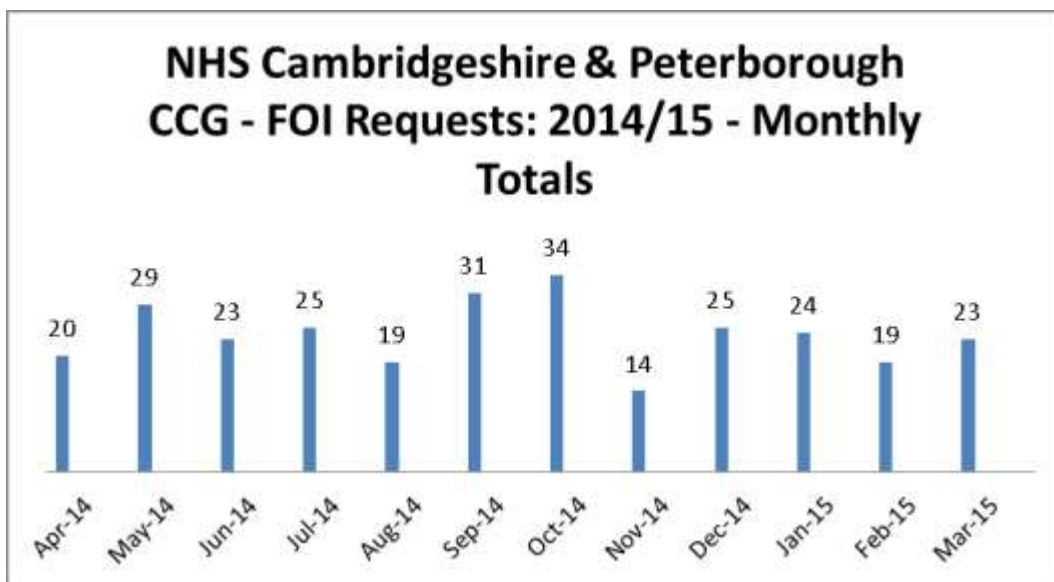
3.1 Total Number of Requests Received

A total of **286** FOI requests were received and dealt with by the CCG during 2014/15. The annual figure and quarterly totals are set out in the graph below.



3.2 Monthly Totals

The graph below depicts the number of Freedom of Information requests received and dealt with by the CCG on a monthly basis in 2014-15.



This equates to an average of **24** requests received each month in the current year, compared to the final average of 22 requests received each month by the CCG in 2013-14.

3.3 Category of Requester

For the purpose of the FOI database each request received is logged under a specific category of requester. The number of requests received for each category is set out in the table below

3.4 Summary of Requests

A summary of the FOI requests received during the year, broken down into quarters is attached as **Annex A** to this report.

3.5 Response Timescales

283 of the **286** requests (99%) dealt with during the year were completed and responded to within the statutory 20 working days. The reason why three requests were not responded to within the required timescale is set out in the table below.

3.6 Requests where information was not provided and (where relevant) details of the Exemptions applied under the FOI Act.

All of the information requested was provided in **191** of the **286** requests (67%) received in 2014/15. The reason why information was not provided (either in full or in part) in **95** cases (33%) is set out in the table below:

3.7 Requests for Internal Review

There were no requests for Internal Review received during 2014/15

3.8 Escalation to Information Commissioner’s Office (ICO)

The CCG received notification of two complaints being made to the information Commissioner’s Officer in year, although the one of these related to an FOI request received in 2013/14 (Q4 - FOI 260). A summary of the issues raised and the subsequent outcomes are set out below.

3.8.1 Complaint Information Commissioner’s Office – Decision Notice: FOI 260 (2013/14)

- The CCG received notification of an escalation of a complaint to the Information Commissioner (ICO) in Quarter 1. This had related to the late submission of a response to a request received in Quarter 4 of 2013/14 (FOI260). The basis of the complaint revolved around the CCG breaching its statutory duty to provide a response within 20 working days. The team that received the FOI had tried to respond to the request rather than forwarding it on to the Corporate FOI Team. As a consequence the statutory deadline for providing the response had passed before the request was brought to the attention of the Corporate Team. An apology was immediately issued to the requester and a response subsequently prepared and issued 18 days after the statutory deadline. The CCG openly acknowledged in its response that it was in breach of the FOIA (Section 10). The requester however proceeded to make a formal complaint to the ICO
- As part of the complaint the requester also challenged the non-disclosure of certain information that the CCG had adjudged to be of a personal nature, resulting in application of an exemption under the FOIA (Under Section 40(2) – Personal information). The complainant also raised

concerns about what he considered to be the CCGs failure to provide an internal review in relation to the late response to his request.

- The CCG gave full support to the ICO during their subsequent investigation, providing relevant information and e-mail audit trails upon request. During the course of this process the CCG re-considered its position regarding the non-disclosure of the information originally withheld under Section 40(2) and informed the ICO that it would be prepared to disclose this information having received confirmation that the individuals to whom this information related were content for it to be released in to the public domain.
- The CCG issued a Decision Notice in relation to this complaint on 16 September 2014. The outcome in summary was:
 - Confirmation that the CCG had breached Section 10 of the FOI by failing to respond to the request within 20 working days as required
 - That as the CCG had not yet provided the information originally withheld under Section 40(2) it had breached Section 1 (1) (b) in respect of that element of the request. The Commissioner required the CCG to communicate this information within 35 days of the decision notice. This was done.
- In the Decision Notice, the ICO highlighted that the CCG had acknowledged the response to the complainant was overdue, explained the reasons why this had occurred and set about dealing with the request. The Decision Notice stated *“Although this does not overcome the fact that its final response was late, it appears to the Commissioner that the CCG did to all intents and purposes take appropriate steps to deal with the complaint in the circumstances”*.
- In terms of the perceived failure of the CCG to carry out an Internal Review the Decision Notice stated *“The purpose of an internal review is to reconsider how a particular request was handled and to attempt to remedy any failings in how that request was handled. The Commissioner considers that in a very practical way the CCG carried out a review of how it handled the complainants request...”*

3.9.1 Complaint Information Commissioner’s Office – FOI 72 (2013/14): No Action

- The CCG received notification of one complaint being made to the In ICO during Quarter 3. This related to an FOI request that was received and dealt with by the CCG in June 2014 (Q1 – ref FOI72). The requester had contacted the ICO directly to complain that a response to his request had not been received. However, having checked the database and relevant FOI file the CCG was able to confirm that the request had been completed and responded to (by e-mail) within the statutory 20 days. This, with

supporting evidence, was communicated to the ICO. The original response with an accompanying cover letter was re-sent to the requester electronically and by post. No further action was taken by the ICO.

4. Conclusion

- 4.1 The response rate within the statutory 20 day period of **99%** for the year shows a good improvement in performance compared against the response rate for 2013/2014 (see table below).

- 4.2 There has been a slight increase in the number of requests received (286) compared with last year (263). Although the increase in numbers is minor the complexity of certain requests received during the year, particularly in relation to those seeking contractual information has been noticeable. Another trend previously identified last year is the gradual increase in the number of requests being submitted by legal firms on behalf of clients and also from fellow health organisations.
- 4.3 Good support has been provided by all individuals and teams approached by the FOI Team to provide responses. There appears to be an increased level of understanding regarding the statutory requirement to respond to FOI requests by a specified time and that to breach the Act is not acceptable. The improved response rate achieved for 2014/15 indicates this.
- 4.4 The Information Governance Team has continued to offer advice and support throughout the year on any queries raised with them.
- 4.5 Overall the CCG's performance in responding to FOIs, overseen by a small team in the Corporate Affairs Department, is considered to be good particularly in view of the capacity constraints experienced in-year. The FOI Administrator, who had responsibility for coordinating the CCG's FOI requests left the organisation in late June 2014 and was not replaced. Instead the responsibility for coordinating and responding to requests was subsumed in to the Corporate Governance Manager's role, although some additional support was provided by the Corporate Services Administrator for a short period until his departure on secondment. This has worked well in year but a watching brief on current capacity and any required cover arrangements will be maintained. The 99% response rate represents very good performance by the CCG for 2014/15. Every effort will be made to maintain this level of performance in 2015/16. The organisation will strive to achieve a 100% response rate but it is recognised that the complex nature of the requests received will always make it difficult to achieve the final 1%. As part of this process the CCG aims to benchmark performance against comparator organisations in future reports.

5. Recommendation

5.1 To note the annual Freedom of Information report for Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Clinical Commissioning Group for 2014/15.
